Groomer Operator Certification Requirements

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

1. Must be a Schroon Lake / N. Hudson Snowmobile Club member in good standing
2. Be twenty one (21) years of age
3. Possess a valid motor vehicle license
4. Be free of any suspension / revocation of operator license in the past three (3) years
5. Possess physical strength, agility and quick reflexes

CERTIFICATION

The candidate must:

- a) Have ten (10) hours seat time with a certified operator prior to operating in each piece of equipment
- b) Have minimum ten (10) hours operating time with a certified operator on board groomer. Will be at discretion of certified operator in each piece of equipment
- c) Must possess or acquire groomer safety course certificate and chainsaw safety certificate through NYSSA (options to be discussed)
- d) Must be willing and able to help with repairs and maintenance of groomers in spring and fall, as well as unforeseen breakdowns that may occur during winter grooming
- e) Must have knowledge of trail system
- f) Must participate in trail work in summer and fall months to get trails ready for winter
- g) **Absolutely no alcohol or drugs to be consumed or used in, on, or before grooming**
- h) Operating privileges can be revoked at any time from club officials for not doing any of the above or neglecting equipment, property or wellbeing of other individuals

All new groomer operators need to fulfill all the above and need to be approved by John Welch as the Groomer Maintenance lead and all other operators.
